Greeter/assistant: Has a warm & friendly smile to everyone who comes to the ranch. Can give directions and answer questions to new faces. Helps keep the ranch office organized and makes sure all release forms have been completed.

Crafty: Your talent is needed. Teach your creative side to kids with different horse related crafts.

Big Kid: Kids love a big kid to play with. Needs to be creative and have a lot of energy. We want you to be an encouragement and let them be kids.

Snacks/Kitchen: Can you bake cookies like your nanna? Are you available to bring snacks to sessions? This will also include delivering drinks from the cooler on the hot summer days.

Picture Taker: Are you a shutter bug? We need picture taken for memories and for future publications/newsletters.

Work Horses: Strong arms and backs are needed for most of these jobs. Will include things such as: construction, repairs, fence building, mowing, weed whacking, hay delivery.

Green thumb: Needs to be able to help water & do light landscaping. Uses creativity to help keep ranch beautiful.

Barn Help/Horse Care: Can help maintain the horse stalls and make sure the horses are fed and cared for. Keep records of when horses are used for lessons.

Horse Instruction: Do you love horses/kids? Can you help a kid find comfort and discipline with horses? Must be an experienced rider.

Cowboy/Cowgirl: Are you an experienced rider? The ranch has a lot of horses that need to be kept ready for the kids. Anywhere from light workouts to attitude adjustments.

Adult Mentors: Do you have a heart for kids? Do you want to touch a life? Do you want your life touched? You can have the opportunity be a mom/dad, grandpa/grandma to a child who needs to experience the love of Christ. Needs to be able to also guide youth mentors.

Youth Mentors: Reserved for older kids, you will have daily contact with the youth at the ranch. You may be one of the few happy faces the kids see all week. This can be a life impacting position for both you and the guest. This is reserved only for those who are serious about helping kids. You will be a big role model.

Professional: The ranch often needs an individual with special skills, to include electrical, plumbing, carpentry, lawyers, accountants, etc. If you have any of these skills and would like to volunteer your services to the ranch, please let us know and you will be contacted when your services are needed. If your profession is not listed but you would like to volunteer, please let us know.
